NAF FIVE STAR BRITISH RIDING CLUBS HORSE TRIALS CHAMPIONSHIPS

Jess Goodwin could not have got us off to a better start at the BRC horse trials championships. Finishing on her dressage score of 24.3 she not only won her arena but was overall senior 80 cm champion. Well done Jess an amazing achievement.

Stoneleigh RC continued their success at the horse trials championships, this time in the senior 90 cm class. Our team of Katie Davey on Prestons Hero, Becca Hickman on TLWS, Anastasia Choma on Henri de Boistron and Clare Boardman on Kims Star were flying the Stoneleigh flag.

Tracey Malka and I had the pleasure of watching them all fly through first water jump where we were fence judging to finish in a well-deserved 10th place in the team event.

Huge congratulations to Clare who finished on her dressage score of 33.0 to take individual 3rd place. Becca also finished with just 1.2 time penalties to add to her dressage score and

came 7th individually, Katie had an uncharacteristic run out on the XC dropping her out of the placings but still had an excellent dressage and SJ round and Annie who was a last minute addition to the team produced a good dressage and clear SJ, just having a couple of stops at the ditch on the XC but a brilliant round considering it was only their second 90 cm horse trials. Sunday saw another successful day at the horse trials championships, this time for Marisa Allright contesting the 100 cm championship as part of the Area 5 team. Marisa produced a good dressage test scoring 33.5, with a clear show jumping round, to take her into the XC phase, where again she went clear just picking up 4.0 time penalties to finish in a well-deserved 7th place and help her team members to secure

We can now look forward to the riding club championships at Lincoln at the beginning of September where we have dressage and show jumping teams and individuals competing.

AREA 5 HORSE TRIALS QUALIFIER

Amazing results at the Area 5 horse trials qualifier kindly hosted by Warwickshire College, many thanks to Wayne Rodwell and his team for a really well run event.

We fielded two teams in the 80 cm class, Our Abbey Team, Bud Jackson, Naomi Cross, Anastasia Choma, Lucy Horner finished 5th and our Park team Jess Goodwin, Wendy Bleloch, Lisa Davis and Clare Taylor Reeves 6th with some fantastic individual results. A win for Jess Goodwin, in Section B of the 80 cm class which has qualified her for the BRC horse trials championships at Swalcliffe on Friday 6th August. Third place for Bud Jackson, 6th for Lisa Davis and 10th for Anastasia Choma. Sadly we need to sack the team manager who didn't get the teams right on this occasion!

Our 90 cm team were on fire, finishing in a well-deserved 2nd place just 1.8 penalties behind the winners. An individual win for Katie Davey representing Stoneleigh for the first time, which qualified her for the BRC horse trials championships at Swalcliffe on Saturday 7th August. Third for Clare Boardman back on the teams with her new ride, with both riders finishing on their dressage scores and Becca Hickman stepping up to 90 cm for the first time just adding a few time penalties to their dressage score completed the team. Following this BRC have awarded Stoneleigh a wild card to the Senior 90 cm championships. The qualifying team will be joined by Annie Choma to complete the team.

Our sole representative in the 100 cm Marisa Allright produced a good dressage, stormed round the XC but a couple of costly fences show jumping gave her 4th place. As there was no team to qualify BRC have invited the riders who finished in $1^{st} - 4^{th}$ place to make an area team so Marisa will be off to represent Stoneleigh RC and the area on Sunday 8th August.

Tracey and I will be the team volunteers' fence judging at the 90 cm championships on Saturday 7th so will give our riders a cheer as they go past.

A great day all round, in extremely hot conditions, thank you also to all the Stoneleigh volunteers who helped on the day, Marion Smith, Clare Taylor Reeves, Laura Marshall, Philippa Gibbs, Tracey Malka and anyone I may have missed, without you these events would not happen.

Dressage to Music Qualifier

Massive congratulations to the three Stoneleigh riders who took part in the Dressage to Music qualifier. Liz Cooper and Anaka scooped 6th place in a closely fought Prelim.

Then Naomi Cross and Harberwain Cherokee took second place in the Novice, with Pam Rose and Oxidised finishing on the same mark and only just missing out on the artistic merit marks to come a very close third. Brilliant results, well done.

Princethorpe Area Dressage Qualifier

Well, what a fantastic day Stoneleigh had at the Area 5 Dressage Qualifier at Princethorpe on 4th July. Three Prelim, three Open and one Riders' Test teams were fielded, with some individuals, with amazing results all round.

Maxine Whitehouse blazed the trail with Rehins Lad winning the Intro C. Then Marion Smith and Star won the Prelim Riders' Test and were second in the Prelim 2. Karen Bennett and Sylvesters Jubilee were first in the Prelim 14, Katie Davey and Prestons Hero first in the Novice 24, Jess Goodwin and Spinway Colm first in the Novice 39 and second in the Novice 28, and Greg Molan and Charlie Harper were first in the Elementary 40, with lots of other riders also in the ribbons.

Then came the team results. The Beech team of Greg Molan, Jess Goodwin, Clare Boardman and Bud Jackson were first in the Open, with the Oak team of Katie Davey, Donna West, Su Morgan and Marisa Allright fourth and the Ash team of Naomi Cross, Liz Cooper, Jo Hayward and Jess Goodwin 6th. In the Prelim, the Village team of Marion Smith, Liz Cooper, Katie Davey and Naomi Cross were third and in the Riders Test, the Abbey team of Marion Smith, Katherine Morton, Marisa Allright and Naomi Cross were also third.

Thank you to everyone for flying the flag for Stoneleigh so brilliantly and huge congratulations to Maxine Whitehouse, Katie Davey, Marion Smith and the members of the Beech team who all qualified for the championships and will join the 70cm and 90 cm show jumping teams and Margaret Hughes at Lincoln on 4th September.

Huge thanks also to everyone who helped in every possible way to make the qualifier a success and special thanks to Alex Darkes and the team at Princethorpe.

AREA 5 STYLE AND SHOW JUMPING QUALIFIER

Next up were our 90 cm riders Marisa Allright, Katie Davey, Karen Bennett and Becca Hickman, who were on fire today, the only team to finish on 0 penalties for the day to take 1st place and individual 3rd for Karen Bennett, 4th for Marisa Allright and 5th for Katie Davey. Marisa Allright also finished 5th in the 100 cm yesterday.
